

Human Trafficking Indicators

- May lack identification
- Transactions may be cash only/cash cards
- When room is cleaned, there is an unusual amount of condoms, lubricant and hand towels
- Several women with one person in charge
- Room traffic (*males*) and length of time visiting room
- Someone helping them check in but not staying in room (*or waiting in parking lot after they are checked in*)
- Person(s) checking in appear to be controlled or “guarded” by one person
- Request of guest for odd room location (*near exit/stairs, etc.*)
- Underage with unrelated adult(s)

*Please report any suspected illegal activity as human trafficking is often discovered by means other than the indicators listed above.
(e.g. drug complaints or noise violations)*
