## Recognize the Signs

### GUESTS

- No luggage or belongings in a bag
- Anyone who appears fearful, submissive, disoriented, malnourished, injured
- Anyone who appears to be controlled by someone

### VISITORS

- Visitors every 30-60 minutes
- Visitors dropped off by someone who waits in car outside
- Underage person with adult(s), after check-in or at odd hours

### HOTEL AREAS

- People loitering or soliciting in common areas, lobby, or hallways
- People appearing to monitor common areas
- Use of hotel computers to visit adult websites
